Supply List "Intermediate Acrylics"

Bring your usual painting supplies: Paints, brushes, palette, easel if you have one, spray bottle, apron, paper towels and whatever canvases you want to work on. I suggest you also bring Golden Acrylic Glazing fluid or whatever your preferred medium is.

You don't need to have all these colors but FYI- these are the pigments I have:

titanium white
hansa yellow medium
cad yellow deep
pyrrole red
quinacridone red
dioxazine purple
colbalt blue
cerulean blue chromium
pthalo blue green shade
green gold
quinacridone nickel azo gold
quinacridone burnt orange
mars black

I use a lot of quinacridone gold [Golden brand] so you may want to have that one.

Most importantly, bring lots of reference material to paint from- any subject that appeals to you. You can bring something in progress to work on if you want to, or start something new. We will do a critique on the first day so you can bring a couple of paintings for that if you like.
