"Light and Atmosphere in Watercolour" Supply List:

- -Preferred Paper: Arches 140lb Cold Press. Bring Several 11"x15" sheets or a block
- -Board to tape your paper. Stretch ahead of time if you like
- -Watercolour brushes, synthetic or sable ranging from #6 round to 1" flat)
- -Paper towel or tissue
- -Masking fluid
- -Ruling pen and/or disposable fine brush for masking fluid
- -Masking tape
- -Container for water
- -Watercolour palette
- -Pencil and eraser
- -Paints: A basic palette of any artists quality colours will do
- -Photo reference of your preferred landscape subject matter.

The following information is for reference only and not a requirement for this workshop:

I work mainly with three primary colours that are staining and transparent as follows:

- -Winsor and Newton Permanent Rose (Quinacridone Red in other brands)
- -Winsor Blue Red Shade (Pthalo Blue in other brands)
- -Winsor Lemon (Lemon Yellow in other brands)

At later stages I use some of the granulating pigments for textural effects and a few of the more opaque pigments for touches here and there as follows:

- -Cobalt Turquoise
- -Manganese Blue Hue
- -French Ultramarine
- -Ultramarine Violet
- -Cobalt Violet
- -Cadmium Red
- -Raw Umber
- -Brown Ochre
- -Raw Sienna
- -Lemon Yellow (Nickel Titanate)
