Federation of Canadian Artists Summer Gallery 2015 Submission Requirements

Summer Gallery 2015

Submissions for *Summer Gallery* run from April 1st to May 29th 2015. For a flat rate of \$25, artists can submit up to eight artworks for jury. This fee is non-refundable.

If successful at jury, artists are required to pay a **\$110 rental fee**. This fee allows the artist to display **three pieces** for **one of the periods** outlined below.

Artists can submit and, if they are successful, deliver **up to six artworks**. As artworks sell we will replace them with additional works by the same artist if they choose to submit more than the minimum three.

Artists may not choose a display period. Their work will be displayed at the discretion of the Gallery Coordinator.

Each display period features up to 27 artists at a time. Three of these places are reserved for SFCA artists. SFCA placements are allocated on a first come first served basis. Interested SFCA artists should contact the Gallery Coordinator via fcagallery@artists.ca

Display Period 1: June 23rd - July 19th Display Period 2: July 21st - Aug 16th

Successful artists must deliver no more than six artworks from their successful application to the Federation Gallery on Granville Island no later than June 21st for display period one and July 19th for display period two. Display periods will be announced by June 6th. Works that arrive late will hang last or refused display.

Only three works per artist will be on display at any given time. Each artist is permitted approximately 6 linear ft. for display.

Historically, Artists who submit small and lightweight works have had the most success with sales during *Summer Gallery*, as these are easily transported and cheaper to ship to overseas destinations.

- Summer Gallery is a juried exhibition.
- Acceptance into Summer Gallery does not qualify towards FCA Signature Status Applications.
- There are no awards granted for Summer Gallery.
- All works must be ready to hang, available for sale, with the intent to sell.
- Artists may submit works that were juried into another FCA exhibition at the same venue.

All information provided by the artist at the time of submission is final.

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- The artist is responsible for ensuring that the information provided at the time of submission is correct.
- The FCA will not change prices, titles, or submission information (including if the work is framed or unframed) after the artist has provided it.
- Attempts to change information after a submission has been completed, or when the artist delivers a work will not be honoured.
- In accordance with existing FCA policy the FCA does not accept photography, digital
 photography or digital art unless otherwise specified. Artists may submit works that were
 inspired from their own photographs, or from photographs where they have
 the written permission of the photographer.

Please direct all submission questions to the Gallery Coordinator via fcagallery@artists.ca. This call is a popular call for entry. We recommend applying before the submission deadline in order to avoid disappointment.
