\*Displayed artworks are subject to change. Renters are encouraged to view the exhibition calendar to see which exhibition their event coincides with. At request of the renter, one gallery wall can be cleared for projection purposes for your event.

\*The FCA can provide 15 chairs for the use of seminars and meetings, included in the cost of your rental. Clients hosting more than 15 guests at their event can arrange for chair / table rental through the FCA for an additional fee.





#### Rates\*:

Tariff	Rate
1) Hourly (minimum 2 hours)	\$250.00
2) Half Day (4 hours)	\$800.00
3) Day 9 AM – 12 AM*	\$1,000.00
4) Two Day	\$1,800.00

<sup>\*</sup>Rates include the cost of one mandatory member of staff to be present at the reception desk for the entirety of the rental, for fire and health and safety purposes.

#### Deposit:

A non-refundable deposit of 50% of the total cost of the rental is due at the time of booking. The remaining balance is due two weeks prior to the rental start day.

#### Cancellations:

The 50% deposit is non-refundable. Full refunds, minus the deposit, will be issued to cancellations made one month prior to the rental date.

Cancellations made after this time will incur the full cost of the rental.

#### **GST Number:**

Please let us know at the time of booking if you have a GST number.

#### Non-Profit Rates and Member Discount:

The FCA is pleased to provide a 20% discount to non-profit organizations and FCA members with memberships in good standing for the duration of their rental. Non-profits must provide their charitable number to be eligible.

#### **Special Occasion Licenses:**

If you'd like to serve alcohol at your event, you must obtain a Special Occasion License and have a Serving It Right Certified person responsible for the service, at additional cost.
