Incomplete, inaccurate or late applications will NOT be considered.

Applicants must meet all the requirements.

Please note that all information submitted is FINAL. Changes cannot be made after submission, before or after jurying.

Please read through the entire application package. There are changes that take place every year.



Submission Requirements

OPTION A: AFCA (Associate) Members applying for SFCA (Signature) status

AFCA members are <u>not</u> required to have been accepted into juried Federation shows in recent years. To apply for SFCA status, AFCA members need to fill in the application form at the back of this package. Applicants also need to **submit 10 digital images** of their work and, of these images, three (3) original artworks must be submitted for live jurying. The standards to which SFCA applicants are held are considerably higher than AFCA applicants.

How to apply:

- 1. AFCA's must start their application process by filling out the "Application for Senior Signature Status" application form found at the back of this package and returning it to the Federation office via email or regular mail. Please submit your application form well ahead of the deadline to allow sufficient time for completing your online submission.
- 2. After review of the application, staff will email you a **submission link** during office hours, which will allow you to upload your 10 images and pay for your application online. This online submission process must be complete by noon Wednesday, February 28th 2018.
- 3. During your online submission process, please indicate in the "Description" field which three (3) out of the then submitted images are of the artwork you intend to deliver to the Federation Gallery for live jurying. Write in the "Description" field, "*Jurying Item #1," "Jurying Item #2" & "Jurying Item #3."*
- These three (3) original artworks must arrive at the Federation Gallery between March 1st and March 15th 2018. Please wait for approval of your online application before sending in your three (3) original artworks to the Federation Gallery for live jurying.

OPTION B: Active Members applying for AFCA / SFCA status

Active members may apply for their AFCA status or apply directly for SFCA status. Note that the standards to which SFCA applicants are held are considerably higher than AFCA applicants. We encourage all applicants to read the article <u>"Composing a Portfolio"</u> and <u>"What happens at the BOG?</u>" available on our website <u>http://artists.ca/membership_chapters/signature_status</u>.

If you are an Active Member applying for SFCA status and are NOT awarded SFCA status you will <u>NOT</u> by default be considered for AFCA status. Bypassing AFCA is not usually recommended.

Eligibility

Active members must have had seven (7) different works accepted into seven (7) different juried Qualifying FCA exhibitions in the past four (4) years. Most <u>but not all</u> Federation juried exhibitions are "Qualifying" shows, as stated in the call booklets and the FCA Exhibition Calendar. If you are not certain the shows you entered are "Qualifying", please contact our office.

As part of your seven (7) Qualifying exhibitions, only two (2) chapter shows per year, to a maximum of five (5) total, may be used in your application. You must have had at least two (2) works accepted into exhibitions which occurred at Federation Gallery in the last four (4) years.



Possible exceptions to this rule are Open National Shows that are held by Chapters from time to time. If you were accepted into a show like this it may be considered on par with a Federation Gallery show in which case it may be used in lieu of a Federation Gallery show. Please contact our office for confirmation if you plan to use a chapter Open National Show in lieu of a Federation Gallery show or if you are unsure whether an exhibition is a Qualifying show or not.

Please note that acceptance into shows other than Federation shows no longer count toward FCA Signature status application.

How to apply:

- 1. Active members must start their application process by filling out the **"Application for Associate Signature Status" application form** found at the back of this package and returning it to the Federation office via email or regular mail. **Please submit your application form well ahead of the deadline to allow sufficient time for completing your online submission**.
- After review of the application and the provided list of Qualifying shows, staff will email you a submission link during office hours, which will allow you to upload your 10 images and pay for your application online. This online submission process must be complete by noon Wednesday, February 28th 2018.
- **3.** During your online submission process, please indicate in the "Description" field which three (3) out of the then submitted images are of the artwork you intend to deliver to the Federation Gallery for live jurying. Write in the "Description" field, "*Jurying Item #1," "Jurying Item #2" & "Jurying Item #3."*
- 4. These three (3) original artworks must arrive at the Federation Gallery between March 1st and March 15th 2018. Please wait for approval of your online application before sending in your three (3) original artworks to the Federation Gallery for live jurying.

Artwork Requirements

Submitted work must be original work by the artist, not copies or derivatives of the work of others or in any way an infringement of copyright.

Artwork that was created in whole or in part during a workshop or class may not be used for application for a Signature status.

Work that has appeared in the Federation Gallery or has been sold may be again submitted for Signature application. Artists are responsible for sourcing and producing agreements with their clients to obtain sold artwork.

The FCA is presently only granting Signature status for work in the following types of media:

• Oil, acrylic, and water media painting, pastel, graphite, pencil, ink, encaustic, collage, mixed media, and original hand-pulled prints as long as your practice is to have a print run limited to 200 or fewer.



Specifically excluded media are:

• Photography, digital photography, digital art, and any art that is not 2-dimensional.

If you intend to include artwork of a media other than what is listed under the "allowed media" section please contact our office prior to submitting your application.

Image Requirements & Online Submission Process

Images must be entered online using the same system we use for our exhibition entries. **We no longer accept image submissions on CD, USB stick or by email attachment.** Please send your completed application form to the Membership Coordinator (<u>fcaadmin@artists.ca or via mail</u>), who will then forward you a link for a submission page which you can then upload your ten (10) images to online.

Images must be prepared according to the Juried Show Submissions Guidelines published on the FCA web site under "Member Resources" on our website (www.artists.ca). Please take great care in the preparation of your images as they will represent your work to the jurors. Think of your submission as a professional portfolio and select your images accordingly. This portfolio is a visual representation of you, the artist, so take care to only select high quality images that reflect the best examples of your work - your portfolio is only as strong as your weakest image. Digital images must be cropped so that only the painting is visible. The painting's frame or background must be removed. Images that are off square, out of focus, over or under exposed, or with excess glare from sun or flash will be disqualified from the jury process.

Images must be submitted in **jpeg (.jpg) format**. We do not accept .tiff, .pdf, .zip or other file formats. We no longer accept printed photos, slides, CDs, nor USB sticks or email attachments.

Please remember during your online submission process to note in the "Description" field whether it is an image of the artwork you intend to deliver to the Federation Gallery for live jurying. Write in the "Description" field, "*Jurying Item #1*," "*Jurying Item #2*" & "*Jurying Item #3*."

Jury

Jurying is completed by the Board of Governors (BOG). The BOG is made up of all SFCA members and jurying is completed by all BOG members who are able to attend the meeting. Jurying for Signature Status is similar to all FCA jurying in that it is anonymous and jurors do not speak to each other during the jury process. Ballots are counted independently by three people including the Standards Committee Chair, the Executive Director, and usually another Board of Directors member.

On average, the jury consists of roughly 20 SFCAs. A majority of votes is what is required to be successful in your application. In the case of 21 jurors, 11 "yes" votes are required for a successful application. In the case that there is an even number of jurors and an equal number of "yes" and "no" votes are cast, the Standards Chair (or designate) will be required to cast a deciding vote.

The 2018 BOG meeting and Signature application jurying will take place on **Sunday March 18th 2018.**

Notification & SUCCESS! Exhibition

All successful applicants will be notified of the Board of Governors' decision by telephone on the day following the jury. All applicants will receive an email notification in the days following. Names of successful applicants will be posted on our website <u>www.artists.ca</u> after reasonable means have been taken to notify them personally.

It is customary for the Federation Gallery to display the three (3) submitted works of the successful applicants for the two (2) weeks following the BOG meeting. The exhibition "*Success!*" will be on display between March 20th and April 1st 2018. Applicants may choose to opt out of the exhibition if they wish. Please complete the "Intent to Show" portion of the application form, informing us whether or not you would like your original artworks included in the *Success!* Exhibition if your application is successful.

Paintings are <u>not</u> required to be for sale for this exhibition.

For unsuccessful applicants, we will endeavor to offer online Signature Status Feedback Sessions for the first time. As this is the first year of this new program we cannot guarantee that all unsuccessful applicants will receive a feedback session though it is our intent to do so.

The feedback sessions will be led by one (1) of the jurors and takes place online via an interactive software so members can participate free of charge and from the comfort of their own home. The instructor will offer feedback on where the artist is in their practice and guidance on how they might improve on their portfolio. Applicants will be invited to join the sessions, but are not required to participate.



Painting Drop-off and Pick-up

Three (3) original artworks must arrive at the Federation Gallery between March 1st and March 15th 2018. Those three (3) artworks must be represented in the 10 digital images you submitted online.

The FCA Gallery is open to <u>receive deliveries</u> 7 days/week between 10am - 4pm.

Upon arrival at the gallery, please sign in your artworks, thereby specifying which three (3) original artworks out of the 10 digital images were dropped off. When shipping your artworks, please send an email to <u>fcaadmin@artists.ca</u> specifying which three (3) artworks were sent to the Gallery.

Unsuccessful applicants may pick up their work from the Federation Gallery starting Thursday, March 22 2017. Works to be shipped will be returned as quickly as possible.

The work from successful applicants will automatically be included in the *Success!* Exhibition which will be shown in the Federation Gallery from March 20th through to April 1st. Assuming the artwork does not sell, these works may be picked up starting Thursday April 5th 2018. If they need to be shipped this will be done in the week following.



Application Checklist

- □ Completed appropriate application form, including "Intent to Show" and "Declaration" (found at the back of this package)
- □ Ten (10) digital images of original artworks submitted online via submission link
- □ Three (3) original works. The three (3) original works **must be** represented and identified in the group of ten (10) images submitted. Extra originals will not be considered.
- □ A non-refundable registration fee of **\$95.00**. Payment can be made by credit card during the process of uploading images. If you prefer, cheques should be payable to "Federation of Canadian Artists".

Rights & Responsibilities

There are rights and responsibilities associated with Signature standing with the Federation of Canadian Artists. For more information please consult our constitution and bylaws which may be found on our website (www.artists.ca) under About \ Governance.

Both AFCA and SFCA members

- 1. Must pay yearly membership fee
- 2. Are expected to act as jurors for FCA and Chapter exhibitions on an as-needed basis.
- 3. Are expected to act as jurors for Active status applications on an as-needed basis.
- 4. Are expected to maintain a consistently high standard of work.

Rights and Responsibilities - AFCA's

- 1. Associate FCA members may use the letters "AFCA"
- 2. Are eligible to participate in their own Medal Exhibition in 2018

Rights and Responsibilities – SFCA's

- 1. Senior FCA members may use the letters "SFCA"
- 2. SFCA members will be asked to participate in the annual Board of Governors' jurying
- 3. SFCA members are strongly urged to serve on the Board of Directors
- 4. Are eligible to participate in their own Medal Exhibition in 2018
