

Take the designated alternate route beginning at Columbia Street and 1st Avenue and follow the signs. There are plenty of route markers, helpful traffic officers and volunteers to help you find your way. Normal traffic routes resume at 12:00 p.m.

#50 Bus Suspension of Service — Bus access to Granville Island will be unavailable for the morning of April 22. The #50 Bus will resume service to Granville Island at 2:00 pm and will follow the regular route from downtown.
