**1. Call to order/Minutes:**

- Dene called meeting to order at 4:05 PST and issued notice of this being the AGM of the FCA; Thank you to everyone for participating via Zoom and introduced the Board online.
- Dene motioned to approve the agenda, Fred second; motion passed unanimously.
- Dene moved to approve the minutes of the 2020 AGM, Kathy second; approved.

**2. Reports:**

**President:** Covid-19 continues to bring challenges for everyone, including the FCA.

**Executive Director:** (Patrick)

Service:

- The FCA was able to acquire additional space on Granville Island for studio and classroom space, which despite Covid protocols is proving successful
- Education program has transitioned to online offering while we manage through Covid
- Creation of a virtual galleries available online at [www.federationgallery.com](http://www.federationgallery.com)
- Addition of Sculptors exhibitions in 2020/21

Growth:

- Highest number of members to date with ¼ located outside of BC.

- New chapters continue to come online. In 2020, a new chapter was created in Edmonton, Alta.
- Continue to reach outside of our organization to create relationships with other non-profit groups such as: Pastel Artists Canada, South Delta Artists Guild, Arts Council of Surrey, Nature Trust of BC, Queer Arts Festival.

#### People:

- Due to Covid challenges, the FCA has seen %50 turnover in staff
- Investment in staff training during 2020/21 (social media bootcamp)

#### Sustainability:

- Covid has challenged the FCA to pivot its revenue generation capacity. We continue to pursue grant opportunities; however we have also increased attribution of donorship and have acquired software to help track and increase donations
- New campaigns are being tested with good success e.g. “I Support the Federation” which raised over \$10,000 in June 2021.

#### Operations:

- As with sustainability, Covid has challenged us to re-think operations in order to serve the membership:
  - Federationgallery.com and federationacademy.com were created which has increased our on-line sales capability substantially
  - Creation of on-line education opportunities is allowing us to expand opportunities across Canada
- Chapter support – we are continually assessing how to best support chapters as they come online. We now produce a quarterly Chapter newsletter and provide Zoom sessions to better understand Chapter needs. We have also spent time overhauling the Chapter Manual.
- Creation of a Juror Orientation Manual to assist new jurors on the process for jurying Federation shows.

#### **Financial Report - Fred** (*Statement Presentation*)

- The financial statements for 2020 were reviewed by Pace Accounting Inc., our independent accountants.
- The review was in accordance with the Canadian Accounting Standards for Not-for-Profit Organizations and approved by the Board of Directors in June 2021.

- Copies of our financial statements can be found on the FCA website on the “Governance” page.
- Highlights of the FCA financial results were presented to the Members.
- Our overall financial position is strong as our management team responded quickly to the challenges of COVID. And importantly, our Members continued to support the FCA through all these changes.

**Motion: Fred moved to continue having PACE accounting review our books/operation; second by Chris; passed unanimously by members.**

**Election of Directors:**

Unless there are objections, it was put forward to a vote to have Dene Croft serve another term as President, Jennifer Heine assume position of Vice President and Fred Oster to serve another term as Treasurer. Approved unanimously by members.
