
With plenty of demonstrations, one-on-one teaching and lively discussion, this mentorship is limited to nine registrants.

Trees give your landscapes character and interest, whether as the main subject or in a supporting role. This workshop is all about how to tackle those trees in your painting. We will be starting off with discussions of how to simplify the trees, looking for their individual shape and contour. By the end of this workshop, you will have much better understanding of how to tackle trees with confidence, starting with simplifying and merging big shapes, understanding the value changes and dealing with the outer limbs and sky holes.

This workshop will emphasize having fun with paint and to boldly embrace acrylics in capturing a variety of landscape subjects.
