CALL FOR ENTRIES

Haiku Inspirations runs April 12 - May 1, in conjuction with the Vancouver Cherry Blossom Festival's city-wide celebration.

This international juried exhibition is open to artists working in all painting, printmaking & drawing media. Abstract, expressive, impressionist or realistic styles are welcome.

Successful entries will combine an original subject or concept and feature excellent composition and skillful use of the chosen medium.

ELIGIBILITY

Entries must not be copies, derivatives, or based in any way on other copyrighted or published paintings, photographs or other artistic works. They must be entirely the work of the entrant, executed without the supervision of an instructor and within two years of the entry deadline. Work must not have been previously exhibited in any other FCA exhibition. All work must be for sale and priced in Canadian funds with intent to sell.

Inadmissable works: Photographs, giclées, posters and any other type of mechanical reproduction. To avoid disappointment, please contact the FCA if you have any questions about eligibility.

HOW TO ENTER

Entries are juried from digital images (max. 2000 pixels, 300dpi.) submitted by e-mail in jpg format only. No CDs or diskettes. E-mail digital image(s) to **fcagallery@artists.ca** and mail entry forms, fees and a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Federation of Canadian Artists.

Be sure to title your jpgs in the following manner: Last name, First name, Title, Size, Medium, Price.jpg i.e. Smith, Joe, After the Rain, 12 x 18, acrylic, \$400.jpg

Three entries per person are allowed, however, only one can be chosen. Poor image quality jeopardizes acceptance.

CONDITIONS

Submission of entry in this competition automatically constitutes the entrant's acceptance of all competition rules. The juror's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

ACCEPTED WORKS

Artists may not substitute another work for an accepted work nor alter the painting or the sale price. FCA reserves the right to refuse to hang any painting that does not match the original entry.

Entries that are accepted for exhibition must remain on display until 4pm, May 1, 2011.

All work must be for sale and priced in Canadian funds with intent to sell. A commission of 35% will be retained by the FCA on all sold work. Artist's price must include this commission. Any sale accomplished by the FCA will have priority over a sale arranged by the artist. Artists must advise the FCA of their HST number if they are registered.

Shipping of paintings to and from the gallery is the responsibility of the artist. The Federation of Canadian Artists and its sponsors are not responsible in any way for the acts or omissions of any shipping agent.

Artists are responsible for loss or damage however caused. Artists are therefore encouraged to arrange adequate insurance coverage against such risks. The FCA and all exhibition sponsors shall not be liable for any loss or damage, whether or not caused by their negligence. The FCA takes every measure to avoid damage and protect the artwork kept in the Gallery.

The image of any accepted work will be retained by the FCA. The artist's signature on the entry form grants the FCA the right to use the image of the accepted work for publicity, educational and reference purposes. Copyright remains the property of the artist. All inquiries regarding copyright will be referred to the artist.
